To Whom It May Concern:

This letter will serve as confirmation to Hillerich & Bradsby and Little League's constituents that the model has received a waiver of the composite bat moratorium placed on 2 ¼" barrel composite bats effective 12/30/2010.

Little League is in possession of a passing test report conducted by an independent laboratory that confirms that the 2013 Louisville Slugger YBAT14-R5, ATTACK -10, did pass the required BPF-ABI testing for composite bats. *However, if in the future, it is determined that this bat fails to comply with the BPF-ABI standard, Little League reserves the right to require the manufacturer to immediately remedy the situation in accordance with your licensing agreement.*

Please utilize this memo as official notification that Little League International will allow the above referenced model to be used during regular season and tournament play.
