

# Improve Your Game

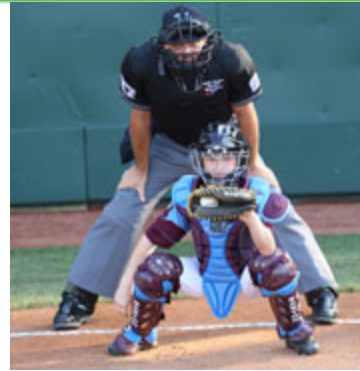

We are pleased to extend a cordial invitation to league personnel to join us in Williamsport, Pennsylvania on March 24-25, 2012 or September 15-16, 2012 for a Little League Umpire Clinic. It will be held in the Dr. Creighton J. Hale International Grove, Dining Hall Recreation Room (2nd Floor).

This Umpire Clinic will emphasize on-field and plate mechanics and ways to better understand the baseball and softball rules of Little League.
