Parking

The current self-parking rate at the JW Marriott Indy is \$59/day. Guests staying at the hotel will automatically receive a discounted rate on their guestroom charges, which also includes in-and-out services.

For attendees driving in daily, Little League will provide parking validations that offer a 20% discount on parking. Parking validations will be available at the Little League Registration area, located on the 3rd floor. Please note that the parking validations do **NOT** include in-and-out privileges.

Valet parking is available for \$80/day.

EXHIBITOR BOOTH CHALLENGE AND SWEEPSTAKES ENTRY

The goal of the Exhibitor Booth Challenge is to entice conversation between the exhibitors and attendees. 5. Tap on the "QR Code Reader" (located under the left navigation menu); do NOT use your phone's camera app
6. Attendees must visit every booth in order to be eligible to win prizes
7. Winners will be notified by push notification on Sunday, February 8

Safety Tips

While the city of Indianapolis takes pride in being safe for conference attendees, it is still a city, and we recommend the following when leaving the hotel:

- Travel in groups, especially after dark
- If traveling alone, it is best to use a taxi or rideshare to get where you need to go
- Do not wear your name badge outside the hotel
 - Place it in your pocket
 - Leave it in your hotel room
- Carry appropriate identification and any applicable travel documentation

Downtown Indianapolis Skywalk System ([LEARN MORE](#))

The JW Marriott Indianapolis is part of the city's downtown interconnected skywalk system which allows for easy access to downtown dining and entertainment options. The skywalks are climate-controlled and ensure a comfortable experience regardless of the weather outside. Look for signs marking the entrances to the skywalks in hotels and venues. Typically, the skywalks are open from 6 a.m. to 11 p.m., but these times are subject to change.

The Indianapolis forecast is predicted to be very cold during Congress with highs in the 20s and lows in the teens. Light snow showers are predicted for Wednesday, February 4, but as of now, the rest of the week is clear of snow. While we will spend most of our time indoors, please pack and plan accordingly for when you will need to be outdoors.
