



CODE OF CONDUCT POLICY

Purpose

The Little League Baseball® World Series (LLBWS) is a celebration of youth baseball, sportsmanship, teamwork, and community. This Code of Conduct establishes expectations for all guests at the LLBWS Complex to help ensure a safe, respectful, family-friendly and enjoyable environment for all guests, participants, volunteers, officials, and staff.

Because this is a youth sporting event, all guests are expected to model positive behavior and help protect the experience of the children participating in the LLBWS.

1. Guest Conduct Standards

All guests are expected to conduct themselves in a respectful, responsible, and appropriate manner at all times. Prohibited behavior includes:

- Use of abusive, obscene, offensive, or discriminatory language
- Obscene gestures or inappropriate attire
- Harassment of players, staff, or other guests
- Any conduct that disrupts the game or interferes with other guests' enjoyment

2. Compliance with Staff and Policies

Guests must comply with all LLBWS Complex rules and directions from event staff, security, ushers, and stadium authorized personnel. Requirements:

- Follow instructions from security, ushers, and event staff
- Present valid tickets upon request
- Occupy only assigned seating areas

3. Security Screening and Entry

All guests are subject to security screening upon entry and must comply with Little League's Prohibited Items and Clear Bag Policy, which is posted at each entry point onto the complex and on the LLBWS website.

4. Weapons

Guns, knives of any size, or weapons of any kind are prohibited.

5. Alcohol

- Alcohol is strictly prohibited on the LLBWS Complex
- Guests who are visibly intoxicated may be denied entry or removed

6. Smoking and Tobacco/Nicotine Use

- The entire LLBWS Complex is a tobacco and nicotine free environment.
- The use and/or possession of any tobacco and nicotine products (including smokeless tobacco, e-cigarette products, vapor/vape pens or similar products) is prohibited.
- There is no designated smoking area on the Little League Baseball World Series Complex

7. Field and Game Interference

- Guests are prohibited from entering the field or any restricted areas
- Guests that enter the field of play will be prosecuted for trespassing
- Interference with live play is strictly forbidden

8. Safety and Fan Environment

All guests share responsibility for maintaining a safe, respectful, and family-friendly atmosphere. Prohibited actions include:

- Throwing objects in any seating areas, on the concourse or in any area deemed to be unsafe by Little League staff
- Endangering others
- Engaging in unsafe or disruptive activities

9. Enforcement and Penalties

Little League reserves the right to determine whether conduct violates this Code of Conduct or any Complex policy. Violations of this code of conduct may result in one or more of the following actions:

- Verbal warning
- Ejection
- Revocation of ticket privileges
- Arrest, legal action, or criminal prosecution
- Ban from all future events

The LLBWS Complex is private property. By entering the Complex, all guests agree to comply with this Code of Conduct and all applicable Complex policies. Little League is committed to providing an environment that reflects the values of respect, sportsmanship, inclusion, safety, and positive youth development.
