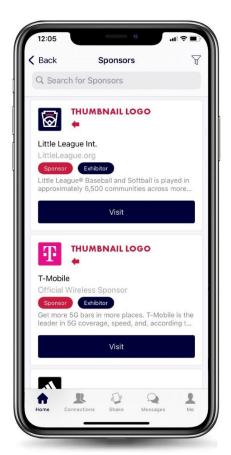
Sponsor/Exhibitor Screens

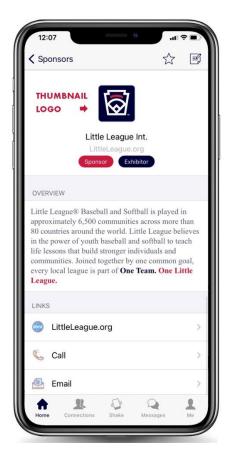

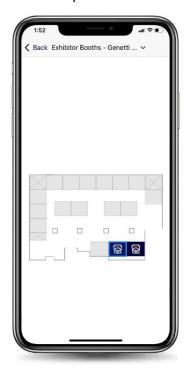
Exhibitor Map + Game/Challenge

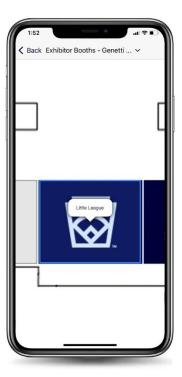
A map will be uploaded to the app that will allow attendees to tap on a booth to see the exhibitor's name and location. To increase interactivity, attendees will be encouraged to visit each booth in the Grand Ballroom at the Genetti Hotel to collect codes (created by Little League) that can then be entered into the Exhibitor Game section of the app to earn points that will be reflected on a leaderboard. Each exhibitor will be given a unique code that they will share with attendees who interact with them at their booth. Attendees who add all codes from the booths will be eligible for prizes provided by sponsors and exhibitors.

Challenge Prizing

We encourage all partners to provide prizes regardless of their presence on-site. We would recommend providing anywhere from one to five items, valued around \$25 per piece, that can be included in the overall prize pool. Little League will create sweepstakes rules and identify winners to distribute prizes to after the exhibit hall has closed. This is separate from giveaways (see below) distributed to all attendees.

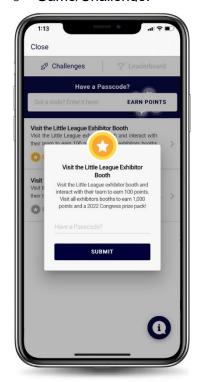
