The selection of players for the various teams within a league shall be in compliance with the Little League Draft Selection System as detailed in the Operating Policies section in the back of the rule book. NOTE: Once a candidate is league age 9 years old or is enrolled for the first time after the candidate attains the age of league age 9 and is assigned and/or drafted into a specific league or division (Example - American/National), the candidate cannot transfer to the opposite league/division during their entire Little League career. This means that a candidate assigned and/or drafted to a minor league or Little League (Major) league team in the American League/Division cannot transfer to a National League/Division team. If the player moves between leagues/divisions, they will be deemed ineligible for tournament play. If a league decides to redraft in any form or trade players, this note still applies.

Method for Operation in First Year of Split League/Division Format (Little League (Major) Divisions Only)

One league/division shall be comprised of the teams that finished the previous season in 1st, 3rd, 5th, 7th, and 9th place, etc. The other league/division is comprised of teams that finished the previous season in 2nd, 4th, 6th, 8th, and 10th place, etc. The draft order is in reverse order of the <u>previous year's finish</u>. Draft order is the same for each round (1,2,3,1,2,3). For example, here is the draft order for 3 teams in each league/division:

First Round:

- 1) 3rd place American League/Division team then 3rd place National League/Division team
- 2) 2nd place American League/Division team then 2nd place National League/Division team
- 3) 1st place American League/Division team then 1st place National League/Division team

Second Round:

- 1) 3rd place American League/Division team then 3rd place National League/Division team
- 2nd place American League/Division team then 2nd place National League/Division team and so on ...

Method for Operation in Subsequent Year of Split League/Division Format

If the league/division was split the previous season and the league uses Player Selection Method Plan A, then teams from the previous season remain in the same league/division the following season and they retain their returning players. Exception: If the number of teams is reduced/expanded players remain in the league/division but may end up on different teams. There shall be no transfer of teams or players from one league/division to the other. The draft order will be the same as the example above but will alternate league/division year to year.

If the league/division was split the previous season and the league re-drafts each year (Player Selection Method Plan B, Alternate Plan B or Plan C) the teams from the previous season are disbanded. The league shall determine the number of teams in each in each league/division. A random draw will determine which league/division drafts first. Managers in each league/division will be randomly drawn for draft order. Returning major division players are only eligible to be drafted to the same league/division they participated in during the previous season. Players league age 10-12 who previously participated in the minor league are the property of the league/division they were drafted to in the previous year and could only be drafted to a Little League (Major) team in that same league/division. All Minor League divisions are required to use the system below, as Minor League teams must be disbanded be disbanded at the end of each season.

Draft picks alternate between the league/division. Draft order is serpentine (ex: 1,2,3,3,2,1) as follows:

First Round: 1) League/Division A Team 1 then League/Division B Team 1 2) League/Division A Team 2 then League/Division B Team 2 3) League/Division A Team 3 then League/Division B Team 2 3) League/Division A Team 2 then League/Division B Team 2 3) League/Division A Team 2 then League/Division B Team 2 and so on..
