COVID-19 Testing

COVID-19 Diagnostic and Antibody Testing

There are two different types of tests — **diagnostic tests (active virus)** and **antibody tests**.

A **diagnostic test** can show if you have an active coronavirus infection and should take steps to quarantine or isolate yourself from others. Currently there are two types of diagnostic tests — **molecular (RT-PCR) tests** that detect the virus's genetic material and **antigen tests** that detect specific proteins on the surface of the virus.

An **antibody test** looks for antibodies that are made by the immune system in response to a threat, such as a specific virus. Antibodies can help fight infections. Antibodies can take several days or weeks to develop after you have an infection and may stay in your blood for several weeks after recovery. Because of this, antibody tests should not be used to diagnose an active COVID-19 infection. At this time, researchers do not know if the presence of antibodies means that you are immune to COVID-19 in the future.


